Re: Enforcement of No Pass No Play in All Sports

Participation in any St. Augustine Catholic School sport activity is considered a privilege. As a student-athlete your child is held to a high standard. Their conduct is subject to more scrutiny than the average student is; subsequently, their behavior must be exemplary both on and off campus, reflecting the goals and mission of St. Augustine Catholic School. Your child is a reflection of the school to the community in every way.

Students must be academically eligible to participate in any sport. In addition, sport fees must be paid, permission slips must be signed and students' health records must be current and on file in the school office.

The "NO PASS NO PLAY" Policy is in effect again for the 2010-2011 school year. Students that fail any content area (religion, math, reading, language arts, science, or social studies) during a grading period will receive a two week suspension from sports. Students that have an unsatisfactory or needs improvement conduct mark in any class or subject during a grading period will be suspended from sports for two weeks. **Any student with a Level II offense or worse (requiring administrative intervention) may be suspended from sports and extracurricular activities (including social gatherings and field trips) for the rest of the school year.**
